▪ Collaboration with Practice/International Collaborations

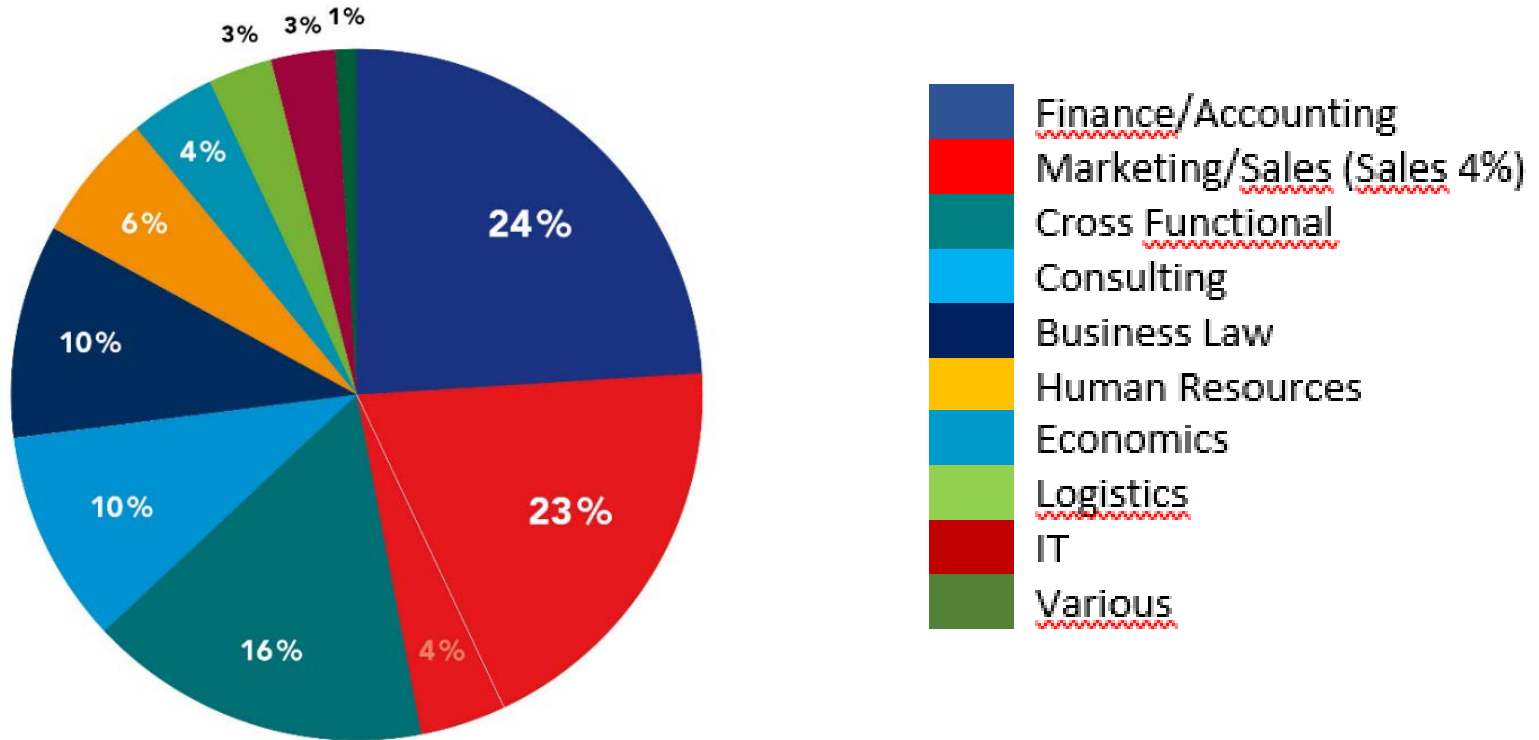

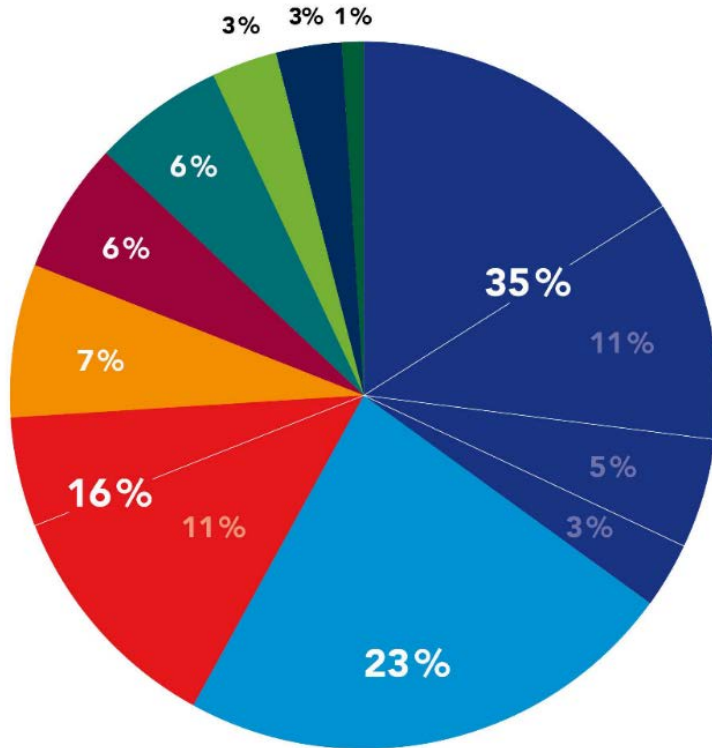

Desired career paths alumni 2017



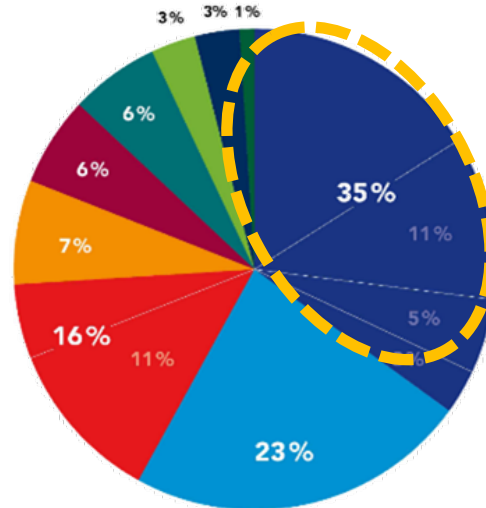
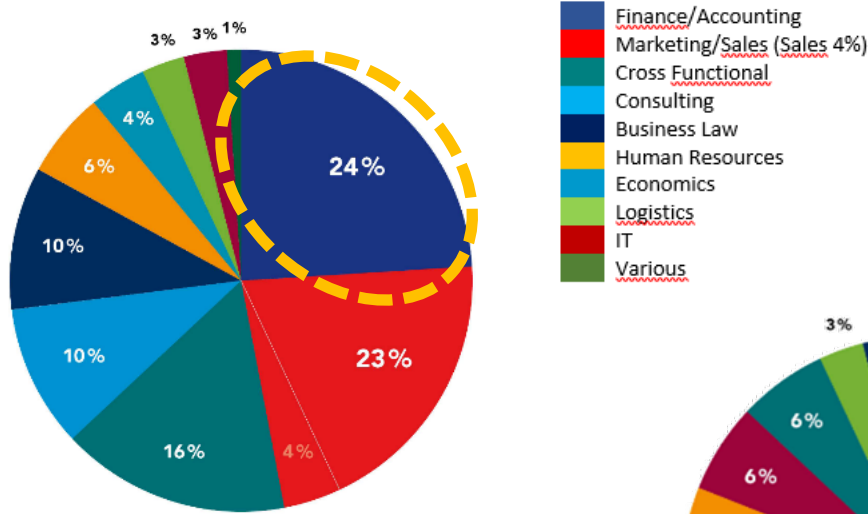
