- »Pan African Federation of Accountants (PAFA)/Fédération Panafricaine des Experts-Comptables (PAFA), was launched in May 2011 to accelerate the development of the accountancy profession in Africa and strengthen the voice of the accountancy profession within Africa and worldwide.

»At the time of its launch in 2011, PAFA was composed of 37 PAOs from 34 countries. This number has grown to 50 PAOs from 42 countries.

#### »Operations

»Almost 100% operations funded through membership subscriptions.

## »Project finance

» PAFA has received project finance from the African Development Bank and World Bank.

## »Ideal Funding Model

» At least 20% operations funded by Donors.



## OVERVIEW OF THE FIVE (5) FOCUS AREAS OF PAFA

- 1. Strong and sustainable PAOs To build strong and sustainable professional accountancy organisation in each African country that contributes to the national development
- 2. International standards and Best practise To influence and facilitate adoption and, implementation of International standards and best practice to improve quality of reporting
- 3. Public Sector To facilitate the accountancy profession to contribute in strengthening PFM systems.
- 4. Regional Cooperation To enhance a common working approach and platforms that facilitates the sharing of knowledge, resources and experiences.
- 5. Thought Leadership To engage in generating cutting edge knowledge and solutions on future issues that will impact the economy, society and the profession.

#### **KEY CHALLENGES**

- » Weak and unstainable PAOs.
- » Current Francophone Africa PAO membership model inhibits growth.
- » Accountancy profession's limited influence in the public sector resource mobilization and utilisation – Corruption and IFF.
- » Embracing of latest technology and related tools.
- » Embracing integrated thinking and integrated reporting.
- » PAFA Secretariat lacks adequate capacity to provide the necessary leadership to overcome the challenges.
- » Small in -country capacity to effectively carry out audit quality reviews.



#### **KEY OPPORTUNITIES**

- » Inter POA resource sharing.
- » Working with OHADA and other stakeholders to address Francophone Africa PAO membership model.
- » Work with the public sector.
- » Embrace integrated thinking and integrated reporting.
- » Enhance PAFA Secretariat capacity.
- » Embrace African Union Agenda 2063.
- » Profession position itself at the centre of fighting corruption and Illicit Financial Flows out of Africa.
- » Regional approach to audit quality reviews.



## STATE OF AUDIT QUALITY REVIEW IN AFRICA

- » Differs from country to country.
- » PAFA working on regional approach to audit quality reviews.
- » ECSAFA model.
- » First step Africa Development Bank funded project:
  - » Developed Audit Quality Review manuals
  - » Manual for Audit Quality Review Regulators.
  - » Developed Training material on the use of manuals.
- » PAFA is hoping for follow up funding to establish regional audit quality review centres
