What are common deficiencies that trigger public sector accounting reforms?

- Missing fiscal transparency and comparability due to nonharmonized public sector accounting standards
- Fiscal illusion

Reforming public sector accounting then implies:

- Significant and government-wide reform
- Availability of sufficient financial resources
- Training of workforce
- Mindset of staff and policy and decision makers
- Advanced project and change management

Political support needed




How to secure political support?

- 1. Awareness raising
 - Show the global trend and make transparent the changes to be made
- 2. User-specific knowledge building for the reform
 - E.g. reasons, objectives
- 3. Show tangible benefits for the various stakeholders
 - Focus on support for parliament and political decision makers
