


Peer-Learning Network of PFM officials in the Asia Region







Public Sector Accounting in Georgia

- Supported by the Economic Governance and Fiscal Accountability Project funded by EU
- Supporting State Treasury to train 420 accountants in IPSAS using PwC's "IPSAS in \bullet Box Application". The App can be used on and offline and has been translated into Georgian.
- Providing Technical Assistance to strengthen consolidation of financial statements \bullet and fixed asset register.
- Reviewing existing accounting manuals to strengthen IPSAS compliance.

Public Sector Accounting in Georgia

- On the audit side, training 80 State Audit Office auditors in IPSAS using "IPSAS in a Box" App but also providing specialized audit training on how to audit financial statements that comply with IPSAS.
- Providing technical assistance to strengthen the audit of State consolidated financial statements, revenue audits, quality control and quality assurance. This involves reviewing and strengthening existing audit manuals and providing training and on the job support.
