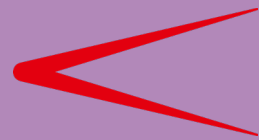

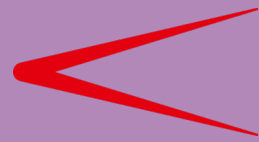

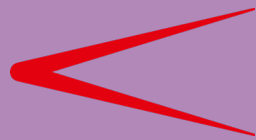
Addressing technological change
