

#### PULSE Pilot assessments objectives



- ✓ The objectives of the pilots are:
  - Test the implementation of the PULSE web-based assessment tool;
  - Identify framework and/or tool inconsistencies during this initial exercise;
  - Detect any potential web-based tool glitches during the pilot test.
- ✓ Pilot application is currently taking place in Armenia and Ukraine.
- ✓ Potential countries for the second round of pilot are: Albania, Brazil, Azerbaijan, Georgia, and Moldova

### PULSE framework 2.0: Update of the methodology taking into consideration that latest IPSAS developments

- IPSAS 43 Leases: Requires changes to PI-10
- IPSAS 44 Non-current assets: This is a new, cross-cutting topic. May require multiple changes or a new PI IPSAS 45 PPE: Requires changes to PI-11 and PI-12
- IPSAS 46 Measurement: May require a new Pl
- IPSAS 47 Revenues: Requires changes to PI-18 and PI-19
- IPSAS 48 Expenses: Requires a new Pl.
- IPSAS 49: Retirement Benefit Plans: To be discussed

- ✓ Continuous tuning and revision of the tool
- ✓ Development of comments exchange forum for QA process
- ✓ Potential use of AI
- ✓ Incorporation of export function at different assessment steps
- ✓ Use of PULSE experience to develop ePEFA tool
