UNIVERSITY OF MONTENEGRO

University of Montenegro is the oldest and the largest higher education, science and art institution in Montenegro. It was founded on April 2, 1974 in Podgorica. The University consists of 19 faculties and 3 science institutes, with more than 20,000 students distributed over several campuses across the country, and its main campus and headquarters are located in the capital of Montenegro, Podgorica.

- Faculty of Economics is one of the most important education and research institutions in Montenegro
- Founded in 1960
- More than 2,300 ACTIVE STUDENTS



Three study programs carried out at the Faculty:


- 1. STUDY PROGRAM in **ECONOMICS** (3 years Bachelor, 2 years Master and 3 years PhD) (Providing basic knowledge in the field of economics studies)
- 2. APPLIED STUDIES in MANAGEMENT (3 years Bachelor, 2 years Master) (Provides skills and professional competencies in the field of economics and business management)
- 3. STUDY PROGRAM in **BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS IN ENGLISH**(3 years Bachelor (Provides knowledge and professional competencies in business and economics)

The faculty offers **five MAJORS**:

Major in Economic Analysis and Policy;
Major in Quantitative Economics;
Major in Finance and Accounting;
Major in Management and Marketing;
Major in Business Informatics.



Conclusions

Montenegro is a green (environmentally-friendly) country and one of the first countries to commit to the implementation of UN 2030 Agenda.

Non-financial reporting is an integral part of the Accounting Law (2016/2021), but given its focus (its audience), it is still not integrated into corporate policy

- The studies show a low level of corporate awareness of this type of reporting

Sustainability reporting is still not formally integrated into the curriculum, but informally it is
