The purpose of the PULSE assessment

- **To support the Government of the Republic of Kosovo in advancing the accounting system**
- **To assess the quality of the PFM**
- **Assessment of conceptual and actual compliance with IPSAS**



Specific objectives of the PULSE assessment

- ***To assess the existing accounting and reporting practices in public institutions***
- ***To identify the gaps in the implementation of IPSAS standards and the challenges of institutional harmonization***
- ***To prepare a comprehensive report with findings and recommendations***



Main Activities

- **Collection of data from public institutions on existing accounting practices**
- **Analysis of financial documentation for the years 2024 and 2025**
- **Comparison of national practices with the requirements of IPSAS standards**
- **Preparation of the final report with findings, challenges, and recommendations**
- **Implementation of the first phase of the transition plan and annual reporting**



Expected Results after the PULSE Assessment

- **A comprehensive report on the state of accounting in the public sector in Kosovo**
- **Recommendations for full harmonization with IPSAS standards**
- **An action plan for the reform of the public accounting system**
- **Increased fiscal transparency and reliability of financial data**
- **Trained staff and a more unified reporting system**
