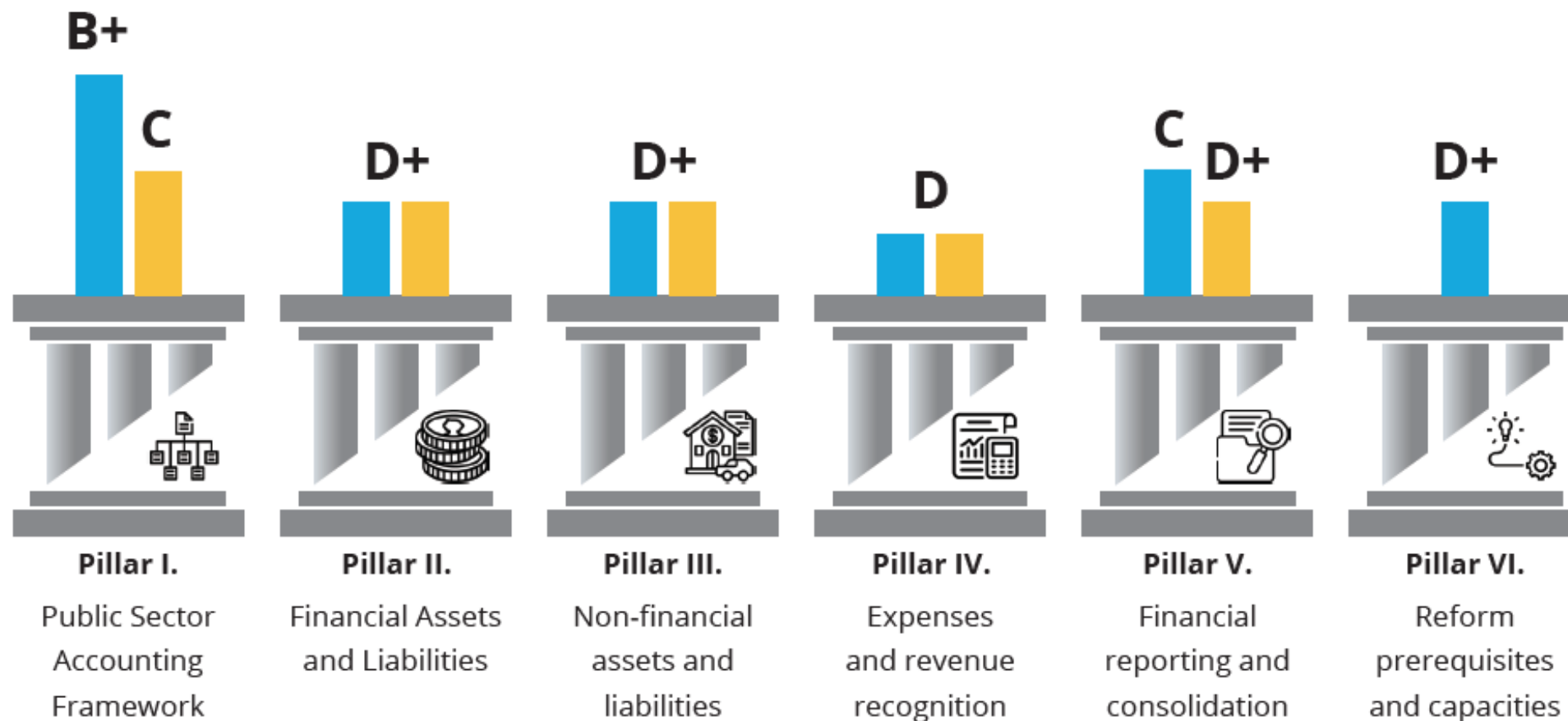

PULSE tool update and upgrade



- ✓ Transition to a new dedicated server
- ✓ Introduction of AI to standardize and enhance the quality of the assessments
- ✓ Assessments comparison and dashboard functionality
- ✓ Regress functionality in the assessment process
- ✓ Improving technical support and issues reporting functions
- ✓ Download of assessment users' report
- ✓ Applying patches, continuous improvement on security
- ✓ Regular backups of database and related files

Artificial intelligence



- ✓ Generate a draft concept note
- ✓ Check the compliance of the concept note and the final report
- ✓ Validation of justification for a specific dimension
 - AI performs analysis
 - Propose revised wording for the score justification
 - Suggests score based on the justification provided
 - Option to accept or reject suggestion

- ✓ PULSE handbook and online tool translation into French, Spanish, and Russian
- ✓ Development of sustainability reporting (SR) readiness assessment and introduction of SR module in the tool
- ✓ Upcoming assessments in Kosovo and Bahamas
