Equity Aversion

- Surrendering ownership and control, giving away part of their business
- Lack of information about availability and alternative sources of finance



Investability

- Not meeting the requirements of external investors
- Not being a fit with the investor
- Not a viable business model for achieving desired returns (e.g. revenue model, product-market fit, property rights, management etc, etc)



Presentation

- Pitching the business, getting interest
- Providing the key information investors are looking for

- Financial literacy and acumen is an important ingredient to provide relevant and credible information for investors and lenders to make decisions but also to manage the financial impact of transactions

 - Other accounting and financial advisors
