» Alignment of legal framework with EU Directives, law and administrative orders.

» Public Oversight as the major challenge.

#### **Success Story**

Alignment of the legal framework with the EU directives, introduction of IFRS (SME) and best practices on the field of audit:

- The law on accounting and audit was aligned with the EU directives and best practices
- -Administrative orders in the field of audit were also aligned with the EU audit directive
- -Initial steps towards QA were over taken
- Enhancement of the financial reporting cycle (explanatory decisions issued of requirements for financial reporting, MOA with Tax administration ext.)
