


















Key Achievements

- 1. Draft laws on accounting and audit reforms, largely in line with the accounting requirements of the relevant EU Directives (Directive 2013/34 / EC concerning accounting and 2013/43 / EC and Regulation 2014/537 on audit of financial statements) have been developed and submitted to Parliament, as noted in the most recent progress report on the implementation of the Association Agreement: https://eeas.europa.eu/sites/eeas/files/ukraine_v2_0.pdf
- 2. Working groups created and are functioning at the level of respective Parliamentary Committee
- 3. Reforms in accounting and audit are supported and carried out jointly by the Government, financial markets regulators and PAOs, aiming to adopt these laws before November 1, 2017.

Key Challenges

- » Timing of the Accounting and Audit Laws adoption;
- » Unexpected changes to the A&A Laws at the Parliament
- » Implementation:
 - » Public Oversight Body establishment;
 - » Secondary legislation drafting & implementation;
 - » Transition period to the new system

How STAREP has helped Ukraine in reform progress

- » Experience exchange with STAREP countries and learning from the experience of leading European countries on specific issues of accounting and auditing reform
- » Assistance in the analysis of current legislation, preparation and expert support of draft laws
- » Targeted activities and outreach events on details and various matters related to accounting and audit reforms: series of seminars for the National Bank on the implementation of IFRS, series of round tables on raising awareness of A&A reforms, events dedicated to raising the quality of education of professional accountants and auditors, etc.
- » Constant contact and interaction with the CFRR team, access to best practices of European countries in the relevant areas

Main expectations of STAREP for 2017-2018

- » Assistance in building relationships and experience exchange with peer regulators
- » Expert support in addressing specific matters in reforming A&A frameworks in line with good international practices
- » Participation at the working group level on processing the draft A&A Laws in the Parliament
- » Promotion of A&A reforms and raising awareness of reform benefits
- » Assistance at the implementation stage, including in the process of forming a new system of public audit oversight and a self-governing body in the audit profession

Topics to be raised at April 29 Roundtable

- » Supporting economic reforms in Ukraine, in particular in the field of accounting and auditing
- » Assistance in including Ukraine in the list of third countries, so the audit reports local auditors are recognized in the EU countries (Decision of the European Commission 2011/30 / EC of 19.01.2011)
- » Assistance in developing a roadmap for the recognition of accounting and audit profession, access to the European professional community;
- » Expert support and technical assistance in the implementation of road map activities
- » Assistance during implementation of the A&A Laws, particularly, in establishing the Public Supervisory Authority
